The Rice University School Mathematics Project (RUSMP) is offering one-week summer math camps at Annunciation Orthodox School's Camp AOS for students who will be entering 2nd- through 6th-grade and two-week programs for students entering 7th- or 8th-grade in the Fall of 2022.

The **one-week** camps (9:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.) will blend content-focused learning and enriching activities to engage students in fun, hands-on mathematics investigations and games with connections to science, technology, engineering.

The **two-week** programs (9 a.m. - noon) will strengthen students' problem-solving and algebraic-reasoning skills and enrich their math backgrounds to prepare them for the upcoming school year. Students will explore topics that may not be emphasized during the school year
