At the request of the educational community, RUSMP has designed courses for students who have **completed** Algebra I, Geometry, or Algebra II and who would like a careful review of the important topics of these courses. COVID-19 has created many challenges for students and their teachers. Learning gaps have arisen through no fault of students or teachers. The RUSMP Brush-Up courses aim to close these gaps.

These two-week virtual courses (Mondays-Fridays, 9:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.) are designed for middle and high school students who want to strengthen their mathematical backgrounds and prepare for the upcoming school year. The courses will be led by RUSMP Master Teachers, whose expertise in teaching these courses is acknowledged in the educational community.
