

2024 Summer Opportunities on the Rice University campus for Pre-College Students

The Rice University School Mathematics Project (RUSMP) is pleased to announce its mathematics summer programs on the Rice University campus for students. RUSMP has designed these programs for students who **are entering** Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, or Precalculus in the Fall of 2024. Students will strengthen their mathematics backgrounds through a problem-solving approach and develop important concepts and skills to prepare them for these courses in the upcoming school year.

These two-week programs (Mondays-Fridays) will take place **July 22-August 2, 2024** and will be led by RUSMP Master Teachers, whose expertise in teaching these subjects is acknowledged in the educational community.

- Preparing for Success in Algebra I for students entering Algebra I in the fall of 2024 (1:00 p.m. 4:00 p.m.)
- **Preparing for Success in Geometry** for students who have completed Algebra I and are entering Geometry in the fall of 2024 (9:00 a.m. noon)
- Preparing for Success in Algebra II for students who have completed Algebra I and are entering Algebra II in the fall of 2024 (1:00 p.m. 4:00 p.m.)
- **Preparing for Success in Precalculus** for students who have completed Geometry <u>and</u> Algebra II and are entering Precalculus in the fall of 2024 (9:00 a.m. – noon)

Enrollment is limited in each program.

Cost per student per program: \$600 (tuition) + \$5.95 (processing fee)
