Using the iPod Touch in the Elementary Mathematics Classroom

This course is designed for **K-6** mathematics teachers. Participants will learn methods of integrating technology into their mathematics classrooms through the use of the iPod Touch.

- Understand basic operations of the iPod Touch.
- Use iTunes and iTunesU to find audio and video content for the mathematics classroom.
- Develop video podcasts.
- Explore iPod Touch applications for educational use.

Each teacher must bring a laptop with the latest version of iTunes installed prior to the first class.

Upon successful completion of the course, each teacher will receive an iPod Touch (32 GB), and receive professional development and Gifted and Talented credit.

Enrollment is limited to twenty-four teachers of grades K-6.

The cost for this course is \$550.
