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1. a. Find the solution set of the equation $2(x-2)+4(x+1)=6 x$.
b. Find the solution set of the system of equations $\left\{\begin{array}{c}y=2(x-2)+4(x+1) \\ y=6 x\end{array}\right.$.
c. Compare and contrast the two solution sets.

Find the solution sets for each of the following one-variable equations:
