

Assessing the Understanding of Solutions of Equations and Systems: Results from the NSF Rice Mathematics Leadership Institute

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1. a. Find the solution set of the equation 2(x-2) + 4(x+1) = 6x.

b. Find the solution set of the system of equations
$$\begin{cases} y = 2(x-2) + 4(x+1) \\ y = 6x \end{cases}$$
.

c. Compare and contrast the two solution sets.

Find the solution sets for each of the following one-variable equations:

$$2(x - 1) = 2x - 2 \qquad x = x + 1 \qquad 3(x + 2) = 5x + 4$$

Compare the solution sets for the following one- and two-variable equations:

$$2(x - 1) = 2x - 2 \qquad x = x + 1 \qquad 3(x + 2) = 5x + 4$$
$$x - y = 8 \qquad x + y = 3 \qquad x - 3 y = 6$$
$$2x + y = 1 \qquad 2x + 2 y = -4 \qquad 2x - 6 y = 12$$

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
